Dundalk Photographic Society achieved second place in the Irish Photographic Federations National shield competition held in Malahide Co Dublin recently. The second place finish was achieved in the colour print section which consisted of a panel of nine colour photographic prints. Two of the colour prints from this panel scored particularly high, Colm Rogan's image Titled "The Pipe" and Brendan Tumilty's image titled "Secret Garden". Dundalk Photographic Society has a strong tradition of success in this competition winning the national shield on many previous occasions. Credit must go to all the non advanced photographers who submitted photographic images for this national competition. Credit also to the selection committee and to senior club member Thomas Gray who coordinates this panel of images on behalf of the club.

International success visited Dundalk Photographic Society in the form of Honourable Mention for achieving ninth place in the International Federation of Photographic Art world cup in photography. From the panel of twenty photographic images submitted by Dundalk Photographic Society to the world cup one image in particular took top place for senior Photographer Michelle Mc Nally. Michelle's image titled "Ellen" a monochrome portrait of a child was awarded the International Federation of Photographic Art Puhar Gold Medal for best portrait image entered in the competition, been awarded a gold medal in this competition carries international kudos in the art of photography.
