



First Competition of 2014 in DPS

With Dundalk photographic society now well settled into the new year of 2014, the Society would like to thank all those who gave their support and guidance throughout the year past of 2013. The society's recent in-house competition which was run for the non advanced photographers allowed those who participated to display their printed images in an open themed competition. Printed images in colour were judged separately from the monochrome printed images. The man whose opinion carried the most weight on the night was in-house Judge and previous society chairman Mr Paul Twibill.

Judge Paul Twibill studied the panel of monochrome images for quite some time before advancing across the panel of images from right to left critiquing and scoring each as he progressed, each author receiving a mark out of twenty and advice. By the time Judge Paul Twibill had completed his scoring of the presented monochrome images it became apparent that there was one author who had been awarded top marks of 20 points. The image which scored 20 points was titled "Pensive" and produced by Mark English, Robert Duffy was awarded 19 points for his image titled "Ciara sitting abandoned " .

Judge Paul Twibill attention then focused on the Colour printed images; these were considered in the same manner by Paul as the monochrome images he had just judged. Again having gone through all the colour images there was but one image which was awarded top marks of 20 points, the image was titled " Daydreamer " and as with the monochrome image winner was produced by author Mark English. Three authors were awarded 19 points Simon Mullen for his image titled "Chestnuts", Francis Mc Keown for his image titled "My Girl" and Robert Duffy for his image titled "Katie Seated"



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
