Charlie Flynn was awarded 20 for his monochrome image "My oh my" and Tony McDonnell received the top mark for his monochrome image "Girl and Wall Painting".

However, bragging rights for the night went to Evalds for "Ready to Jump" his stunning image of a red squirrel getting ready to jump off a branch. Congratulations to Evalds and, once again, congratulations to every one who participated.
