He is essentially a documentary photographer and has won many awards and distinctions for his individual images and panels of pictures. Des is recognised as an expert darkroom printer and both his fellowships [RPS and Irish Federation] were achieved with monochrome panels. Today he works mainly in colour documenting Irish life and the countries he visits.
